A quick note for visitors: If you have family, friends, or contractors visiting, please kindly remind them of these guidelines before they arrive.

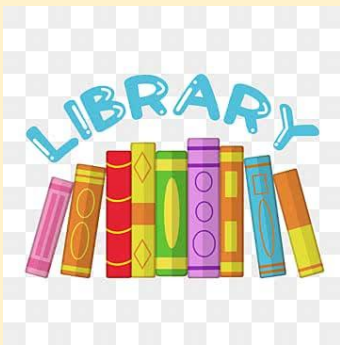

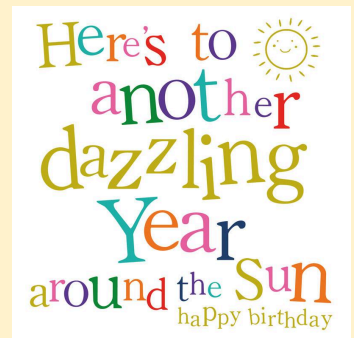
